Dear Families:

The Piscataway Township School District is continuing our community arts partnership with American Repertory Ballet for the 2018-2019 school year. The District offers students an opportunity to participate in Dance Power, one of our LEAP (Local Enriched Academic/Arts Program) offerings. Dance Power is a dance program offered to students in grades 2 and 3 through LEAP and in partnership with the American Repertory Ballet. Participating students will work with a dance teaching artist one time per week during school hours for approximately one hour.

Using the Dance Power curriculum guided by the state standards for dance, American Repertory Ballet will focus on the development of the fundamentals of dance and movement by engaging students through creative performance opportunities. By working closely with the dance teaching artist, students will co-create a performance piece based on an integrated subject area of learning agreed upon by the teaching artist and classroom teacher. As a result, students will gain further experience in critique as they analyze their own work and the work of their peers.

This eight week program is scheduled to begin on January 9, 2019 at Eisenhower, Grandview, Knollwood, and Randolphville Elementary Schools for students in 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade. Interested students and parents should fill out the application on the attached form. We have limited capacity for this program. Applications will be reviewed and you will be notified by mail if your child has been accepted into the program. All forms must be returned to your child's teacher no later than **Wednesday, December 19, 2018.**
